

PTLLS

Level 3 Award in Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector

A 30 hour course delivered by Liz Keable (BSc (Hons), PGCE, MifL, MInstLM) over 12 weeks, (2.5 hours per session), with an additional 30 hours of personal study and preparation in student's own time over the same period. The course meets the minimum standard for all those entering teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector. Completing the PTLLS award will equip candidates with the knowledge and skills required to develop and deliver programmes, provide learning support and take responsibility in managing the learning process in post-16 education.

The qualification is part of the Qualifications Credit Framework (QCF) and is mapped to the Lifelong Learning UK (LLUK) mandatory unit, which relates to the NOS 'Professional standards for teachers, tutors and trainers in the lifelong learning sector'. On achieving this qualification, candidates may progress onto a level 3 or level 4 Certificate in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector (CTLLS) or the Diploma in Teaching in the Lifelong Learning Sector (DTLLS).

This opportunity is ideal for anyone newly entering a teaching/ training role, as well as those already in service, who require the minimum threshold trainer status for their work in a further education college or adult and community learning centre. It also covers roles with work based learning providers or adult training organisations. Assessment will be through 3 marked assignments, including a microteach session observed by peers. The course will run on:
