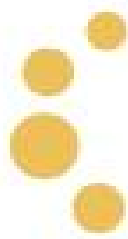

TRANSFORM is a unique and exciting project for adults aged 19 + who are living in or accessing supported housing services in Norfolk. It will take place from November 2009 to March 2010.

It will give people, often overlooked by mainstream education, an opportunity to take part in the Learning Revolution.

Through a series of action learning events across the county, TRANSFORM will motivate and encourage people to design creative and imaginative activities to benefit marginalised individuals and socially excluded groups.

This project incorporates high levels of service user expertise and involvement.

TRANSFORM seeks to build social networks and peer groups which will inspire people to overcome barriers to community learning and provide stepping stones into community education, volunteering, enterprise and employment.

TRANSFORM is a cross sector partnership between the supported housing and the education and training sectors in Norfolk.
