Level 3 Award in Volunteer Management

Who can do the qualification?

The Level 3 Award in Volunteer Management is suitable for anyone who manages volunteers either in a voluntary or paid capacity.

What does the qualification comprise?

The course consists of six units. More details on the units are contained in this [Lantra leaflet](#). Or please phone us for a paper copy.

What is involved?

The training will take place over 6 days - 1 day a fortnight, spread over approximately 12 weeks. The qualification is assessed by a single project (work book) marked by an external Examiner.

How do you secure a place?

The courses are being delivered through Voluntary Sector Training but candidates for free places need to be assessed for eligibility for a bursary before a place can be confirmed.
